This week, the Los Altos School District ("LASD") kicked off a community engagement process as part of the agreement to find long-term facilities for BCS. You may remember that we <u>agreed to a two-year facilities solution</u> back in May that allowed LASD more time to engage the community on a long term plan.

LASD has hired an independent consultant, MIP, to run the community engagement process. There will be multiple opportunities for the whole community to be involved and we encourage you to share your voice. LASD has convened a project team to oversee the process, and I am happy to say that one of our board members, Francis LaPoll, is part of that team and will represent BCS's interests in these discussions and ensure a fair process.

Your participation is critical to this process. We'll be reaching out next week with more information about a meeting at BCS to discuss the community engagement plan and ensure your voices are represented and heard.
